

#### **Wild Grapes at Harvest**

(Matthew 21: 33 - 43)

It sounds like the same story repeated from Isaiah: a vineyard fails to produce a harvest. But this time, it's not grapes that fail, but the farmhands who work the land. The harvest is available, but the workers won't give it up to the owner. They're willing to go far beyond selfishness. They'll accept bloodshed to hold onto what they see rightfully theirs.

Isaiah's parable presents sin in a passive light: a failure to produce what's good. Jesus tells a story of sin that's about actively choosing to pervert the good. These two kinds of sin have been called "acts of omission and commission" by the church. They are "what we have done and failed to do," as we confess at Mass. We are responsible for both behaviours: choosing not to do good as much as the deliberate decision for evil. Even in Jesus' time, people boasted of keeping the Ten Commandments, as though that fulfilled their obligation to God. But the absence of active evil is not the same as the presence of love.

#### Pray

Go out with ways of wisdom for the Holy One: faithfulness, loyalty, reverence, stillness, respect.
Go out with ways of wisdom for community: mutuality, honour, generosity, truthfulness, contentment.
Go out in the wisdom of Christ that enable all creation to flourish in the ways of love: forgiving, healing, restoring, creating, life. Amen.

#### **Ponder**

"Cease doing evil. Learn to do good" (Isaiah 1: 16 - 17). Turn down one temptation to uncharity every day and replace it with a conscious choice to be gracious. "God's kingdom will be taken back from you and handed over to a people who will live out a kingdom life".

#### Kids' Corner

Keep on doing what you have learned and received and heard and seen in me. (Philippians 4: 9)

As you grow older, you will learn many new things. The subjects you study in school get more challenging, and your life changes. But the most important things you learned about God when you were younger will stay the same. For instance, you learned that God loves you. You learned to love others and be kind to them. Those things never change because God never changes – even when we do.

Today, think of one way you've grown in the last year. Spend some time thanking God for what you've learned.

# MENTAL HEALTH IN TODAY'S CULTURE - A REFLECTION ON WORLD MENTAL HEALTH DAY

TUESDAY 10 OCTOBER 2023 7.30PM - 9PM

Keynote Speaker: Professor Patrick McGorry AO

Executive Director of Orygen and Professor of Youth Mental Health at the University of Melbourne and former Australian of the Year



Pat is a psychiatrist known world-wide for his development and scaling up of early intervention and youth mental health services and for mental health innovation, advocacy and reform.

He is Professor of Youth Mental Health at the University of Melbourne, and founding editor of the journal Early Intervention in Psychiatry.

He led the advocacy which resulted in the establishment by the Australian Government in 2005 of the National Youth Mental Health Foundation, which in 2006 became Headspace and he remains a founding board member of that organisation.

He has played a key advocacy and advisory role to government and health system reform in Australia and in many parts of the world.

In 2010 Professor McGorry was selected as Australian of the

Year and became an Officer of the Order of Australia.

In 2016 he became the first psychiatrist to be elected as a Fellow of the Australian Academy of Science.

In 2018 he received the Schizophrenia International Research Society Lifetime Achievement Award and in 2019 the Humanitarian Award of the Society of Biological Psychiatry and the NHMRC Research Excellence Award.


