

Faithful in Small Matters

(Matthew 25: 14 - 30)

I was talking to a group of small children about the gifts God had given them. One girl seemed unconvinced. Her older sister, she told me with dewy-eyed admiration, had all the talent in the family: intelligence, athletic ability, and creativity. She herself, however, had none.

On the contrary, I assured her, she had many gifts of her own. She had a generous love for her sister, a pleasant personality, a warm smile, and a way of making people happy to talk with her. These were talents from God, too, and I urged her to name other things she was good at that were less obvious than these.

Some weeks later I was at home, having a bad spell of writer's block, and began to feel frustrated with the blank computer screen. Going to the mailbox to retrieve my letters, I noticed one printed in pencil. It was from the little girl I had spoken with, and inside the envelope was a crayon drawing with these simple words pencilled alongside: You have talents. God created you to use your talents. NAME THEM. In a moment, my sense of failure was gone, replaced by a child's wonderful courage. She gave the story of the talents back to me multiplied, and I got back to work exhilarated.

What talents have you been given by God, and how have you invested them?

You give us different gifts, Loving God. Help us to use them wisely. We will not give in. We will not give up. We will keep on using our gifts. A parable that encourages us to use the gifts God has given us to the full. I will not give in. I will not give up. I will keep on using my gifts. Amen.

Give thanks to a woman who has inspired you with her holy fidelity. If possible, call or write and tell her what her example has meant to you. If not, spend a day appreciating her by emulating her witness. "If you knew I was after the best, why did you do less than the least".

Have you ever tried to find something in a dark room? Not easy, is it? Maybe you bumped your knee or tripped and fell. Ow! This week we received confirmation that the Good Shepherd school hall will be undergoing major refurbishment starting Monday 20 November. We have been advised that this work is expected to take around 6 months to complete. Parish Masses and events will be impacted including access to the church when parking at the school carpark. The initial changes include:

- Weekend Masses— we will set up chairs in the foyer meeting room and outside as required.
- **Weekday Masses**—will be moved to the parish office due to construction noises.
- Car Park and access— those who park at Good Shepherd school carpark will need to access the top gate of the school by following the red line below.
- Christmas Masses—these will be held at St John Paul II College, Gungahlin Drive, Nicholls.

Please be patient with us as we navigate the upcoming disruption to church access and services. We will tweak the arrangements as we receive more information and will keep you updated on any changes. Please contact the parish office if you have any questions or concerns.



Volunteer Opportunity - Parish Finance Council


The Parish is looking for a person to fill the role of Treasurer on the Parish Finance Council. The role of the PFC is to monitor the finances of the parish and advise the Parish Priest and Parish Pastoral Council on budgets, income, expenditure, future trends, and financial requirements.

This involves attending four meetings per year (roughly every three months). The meetings generally last about one and a half hours. There is a small amount of reading and email correspondence. Someone who has an understanding of income and expenditure statements and balance sheets would be desirable.



Please note that the role of Treasurer is assisted by the parish finance officer. He prepares the monthly financial statements, quarterly BAS, annual financial reports, annual budgets, meeting agendas and deals with various financial issues.
