Ultimate Power

The church year ends this week. Our calendar is not far behind. These endings carry a certain finality about them. We've spent the year studying Matthew's gospel, with its emphasis on God's kingdom. We look forward to the start of a new cycle following Mark, who ponders the identity of Jesus and the meaning of his coming. We're always glad to get to Advent, the happy season of warmth and giving. But before we leap into tomorrow, this church year has one more lesson to teach us.

The liturgical calendar always ends with Christ the King (Jesus Christ, Heart of the Universe), but the readings for this feast are remarkably different each time. In Matthew's year, Christ's kingship is defined in terms of judgment. A ruler has the power to separate good from evil, lives worthy of reward from those deserving punishment. Rulers establish the rules and enforce them. But in Matthew's judgment scene, the rules turn out to be completely different from what everyone expected. The Son of Man doesn't quiz people about whether they went to church or obeyed the commandments. No one is asked about divorce or sexual purity or saying their prayers. What does concern the king is how the saddest members of society are being treated.

If we took the quiz today, how would we do? This is an appropriate reflection for the end of the year. It's also a good time to consider how we might prepare to pass this exam at the mother of all endings.

Pray

Joy-making, shepherding God, your love, goodness, mercy, and grace are constantly before us. May we know you so well that we implicitly trust you, and unselfconsciously live to your glory and praise. Amen.

Ponder

Find a way to answer the needs of the hungry and thirsty, the stranger and the naked, the sick and imprisoned, in the upcoming year. Gifts of generosity, hospitality, and compassion are always in season. "I'm telling the solemn truth: Whenever you did one of these things to someone overlooked or ignored, that was me – you did it to me".

Kids' Corner

... whatever you did for one of the least brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me. (Matthew 25: 40)

On her way to school, Marty smiles at an old man waiting at the bus stop. Marty has no idea that the man is on his way to visit his wife in the hospital, but her smile cheers him up. He's still smiling when he gets on the bus. Earlier, someone was rude to the bus driver, but the man's smile makes him forget, and the driver smiles at the next person he sees – a teenager who wants to run away from home. The teen can't help smiling back. She decides to go home and smile at her mum instead of running away. All this good was started with one smile.

Good Shepherd Hall Refurbishment

Work has now begun at Good Shepherd school hall and parishioners should take care when accessing the church as there are construction fencing near walkways. Parish Masses and events will be impacted including access to the church when parking at the school carpark. The initial changes include:

- ♦ **Weekend Masses** we will set up chairs in the foyer meeting room and outside as required.
- ♦ **Weekday Masses**—will continue to be at the church until the noise level becomes unmanageable.
- ◆ Car Park and access— those who park at Good Shepherd school carpark will need to access the top gate of the school—the gate closest to the church near the school hall will be locked.
- ♦ Christmas Masses—these will be held at St John Paul II College, Gungahlin Drive, Nicholls.

Please be patient with us as we navigate the upcoming disruption to church access and services. We will tweak the arrangements as we receive more information and will keep you updated on any changes. Please contact the parish office if you have any questions or concerns.


